ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 1st day of September, 1938.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Whereas the trade agreement between the Dominion of Canada and the Dominion of New Zealand (being the agreement ratified by the Trade Agreement (New Zealand and Canada) Ratification Act, 1932, and modified by Order in Council dated the 18th day of November, 1935,* and by the Trade Agreement (Canada) Order 1938)† is due to expire on the 30th day of September, 1938:

And whereas it has been mutually agreed that the said agreement

be extended to the 30th day of September, 1939:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by the Customs Amendment Act, 1921, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf. His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare and order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Trade Agreement (Canada) Order 1938, No. 2.
- 2. The said agreement, ratified by the Trade Agreement (New Zealand and Canada) Ratification Act, 1932, including and subject to the aforesaid modifications thereof, shall continue in force up to and including the 30th day of September, 1939.
