THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section 5 of the Termites Act, 1940, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Termites Act (Application) Order 1943.
2. The local authority set out in the Schedule hereto is declared to be a local authority to which the provisions of the Termites Act, 1940, apply.
3. This Order in Council shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.
