ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 2nd day of August 1961

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Trade Arrangement (Israel) Order 1959, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Trade Arrangement (Israel) Order 1959* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) The principal order shall hereafter apply in the Cook Islands.

(2) The principal order is hereby consequentially amended by revoking clause 3.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the Trade Arrangement (Israel) Order 1959. The effect of the amendment is that the Most Favoured Nation Tariff will apply to goods being the produce or manufacture of Israel that are imported into the Cook Islands.
