PURSUANT to sections 9 and 10 of the Tariff Act 1988, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order 1989.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1989.
