Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 May 2006, inserts a new concession reference number 66 into Part 2 of the Tariff.

The new concession item relates to goods that are re-entered after repair or alteration—

- in the territory of Singapore or a specified party to the Trans-Pacific Strategic Economic Partnership Agreement that was opened for signature by Brunei Darussalam, Chile, New Zealand, and Singapore on 15 June 2005; and
- in accordance with Article 3.5 of that agreement.
