- 1 Title**
This order is the Tariff (Concession) Amendment Order 2007.
- 2 Commencement**
This order comes into force on 1 September 2007.

3 Tariff amended

Part 2 of the Tariff is amended by revoking paragraph (c) of reference number 82 and substituting the following paragraph:

- (c) 3 bottles, or other containers, containing in each bottle or container not more than 1 125 millilitres of alcoholic spirits, liqueurs, or other spirituous beverages

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 September 2007, raises the duty free allowance for alcoholic spirits (including liqueurs) brought into New Zealand by passengers. The new concession applies to 3 bottles of spirits, with a limit of 1 125 millilitres per bottle.
