ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of April, 1946

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Transport (Goods) Applied Provisions Order 1942, Amendment No. 1.

2. This Order shall be read with and form part of the Transport (Goods) Applied Provisions Order 1942* (hereinafter called the principal Order).

3. Regulation 4 of the principal Order is amended—

(a) By inserting in paragraph (e), after the word "milk", the word "cream"; and

(b) By adding thereto the following paragraph :---

"(f) Solely for the purpose of providing relief or assistance to the inhabitants of a locality where the usual communications are interrupted by the happening of flood, earthquake, or fire."
