**THE TELEPHONE AMENDING REGULATIONS 1939.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

**ORDER IN COUNCIL.**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 30th day of September, 1939.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Telephone Amending Regulations 1939.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Telephone Regulations made on the 17th day of September, 1923,\* as amended by regulations made on the 5th day of August, 1935,† and the 7th day of February, 1936,‡ all of which regulations are hereinafter referred to as “the Telephone Regulations.”

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1939.

4. The Telephone Regulations are amended by inserting next after Regulation 106 thereof the following additional regulation :—

“ 106A. In respect of any toll call on which the charge as calculated in accordance with Regulation 106 exceeds 3d., there shall be added to the chargeable amount the sum of 1d. for each 6d. (or fraction thereof) of toll charge.”
