



**THE TIRES AND TUBES CONTROL NOTICE 1942,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939 and the Munitions Emergency Regulations 1941, the Minister of Supply and Munitions doth hereby give notice and direct as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Tires and Tubes Control Notice 1942, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tires and Tubes Control Notice 1942\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. Clauses 5, 6, and 7 of the principal notice are hereby amended by omitting from each clause all words after the words “precedent consent of”, and substituting in each case the words “the Commissioner of Supply or of some other person appointed by the Commissioner of Supply for the purpose”.

3. All persons heretofore appointed by the Secretary, Ministry of Supply and Munitions, for the purpose of clauses 5, 6, and 7 of the principal notice whose appointments are effective at the date of this notice shall, without further appointment, be deemed to be appointed by the Commissioner of Supply for the purpose of the said clauses.
