TRADE ARRANGEMENT WITH BELGIUM (APPLICATION TO GREECE) ORDER, 1936.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Acts pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Customs Amendment Act, 1921, section 3 of the Trade Arrangement (New Zealand and Belgium) Ratification Act, 1933, and all other powers and authorities enabling in this behalf.

Date of enactment : 22nd day of October, 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 29th day of October, 1936.

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade Arrangement with Belgium (Application to Greece) Order, 1936.

2. The duties and exemptions from duty provided for by the Trade Arrangement (New Zealand and Belgium) Ratification Act, 1933 (as modified by Orders in Council made on the 3rd day of December, 1934,* and the 28th day of August, 1936,† respectively), in respect of goods being the produce or manufacture of the Economic Union of Belgium and Luxemburg is hereby applied to similar goods being the produce or manufacture of Greece.

3. Every application of duties and exemption from duty hereby effected shall be subject to the provisions of section 143 of the Customs Act, 1913, and all duties of Customs that have become due and payable and all penalties and forfeitures that have been incurred prior to the coming into force of this Order shall be recovered and enforced as if this Order had not been made.

4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of September, 1936.
