Pursuant to section 9 of the Tariff Act 1988, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Tariff (Alcoholic Beverages) Amendment Order 1995.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- **2. Tariff amended**—The Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to Tariff items 2208.20.08, 2208.30.08, 2208.40.08, 2208.50.08, and 2208.90.37, and substituting the Tariff items, rates of duty, and statistical keys specified in the Schedule to this order.
- **3. Revocation**—The Tariff (Alcoholic Beverages Indexation) Amendment Order (No. 2) 1995 (S.R. 1995/155) is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to Tariff items 2208.20.08, 2208.30.08, 2208.40.08, 2208.50.08, and 2208.90.37.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into effect on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, amends the rates of duty of certain Tariff items specified in the Tariff (Alcoholic Beverages Indexation) Amendment Order (No. 2) 1995.

Those rates did not correctly reflect the changes in excise duty rates effected by the Excise Duty (Alcoholic Beverages Indexation) Amendment Order (No. 2) 1995. This order corrects the error.
