



**THE TOBACCO BOARD ELECTION REGULATIONS 1975,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of August 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Tobacco Growing Industry Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Tobacco Board Election Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tobacco Board Election Regulations 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Nominations—Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

“(1) No person shall be eligible for election unless his name appears on the roll and he has been nominated in writing by two other persons whose names appear on the roll, and unless he has accepted nomination in writing to the Returning Officer.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for all individuals on the electors roll to be eligible for election to the Tobacco Board as growers representatives, thus removing an anomaly that persons nominated by a corporate body or partnership, to vote in an election, were not eligible for election unless they personally were licensees.
