THE TROUT-FISHING (HAWKE'S BAY) REGULATIONS 1940.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 7th day of February, 1940.

THE HON. H. G. R. MASON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Hawke's Bay) Regulations 1940.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations for the Hawke's Bay Acclimatization District and the waters thereof, made on the 11th day of November, 1929* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations), and the amendment thereof.

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. No person shall troll for fish from any motor or other mechanically propelled launch or boat in any part of Lake Tutira.
