PURSUANT to section 9(1) of the Tariff Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Tariff Concessions (Baggage and Effects Accompanying Passengers) Amendment Order 1990.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1990.

2. Tariff amended—The Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the descriptions and rates specified in concession reference number 81 of Part II, and substituting the new descriptions and rates specified in the Schedule to this order.

3. Revocation—The Tariff Concessions (Baggage and Effects Accompanying Passengers) Amendment Order 1989* is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 December 1990, amends the concession relating to personal baggage and effects accompanying a passenger in Part II of the Tariff, by increasing the duty free exemption from \$500 to \$700.
