ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 21st day
of June, 1944

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Certificates Amending Regulations 1944, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations for the examination and classification of teachers made under the Education Act, 1914, by Order in Council dated the 22nd day of December, 1931* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1944.

APPLICATION OF THESE REGULATIONS

2. These regulations shall apply with respect to every teacher—

- (a) Who is the holder of a Teacher's Certificate on the coming into force of these regulations ; and
- (b) Who served in New Zealand or elsewhere as a member of His Majesty's Forces in the last war with Germany (whether or not he was the holder of a Teacher's Certificate at the time of his service with the said Forces).

SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR THE GRANT OF HIGHER CERTIFICATES TO
TEACHERS TO WHOM THESE REGULATIONS APPLY

3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the principal regulations, any teacher to whom these regulations apply may be granted a Teacher's Certificate of the class higher than the class of the certificate for the time being held by him on passing such examination or examinations as in the opinion of the Director are the equivalent of the examination or examinations that he would have been required to pass if he had been a candidate for examination for such certificate at any time during or after his service with the Forces and before the coming into force of the principal regulations.
