PURSUANT to section 9 (1) of the Tariff Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Tariff Concession (Revocation of Reference 33) Order 1990.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1990.
- 2. Tariff amended—Part II of the Tariff is hereby amended by revoking reference number 33 and the description of goods and rates of duty specified for that reference number.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 October 1990, revokes concession reference number 33 and its description of goods and rates of duty. With goods of Australian origin now entering New Zealand free of duty, concession reference number 33 is now obsolete.
