THE TRAINING COLLEGE REGULATIONS 1926, AMENDMENT NO. 16.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Education

Act, 1914.

Date on which the regulations were made : 8th day of December, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette* : 9th day of December, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Training College Regulations 1926, Amendment No. 16.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 13th day of December, 1926* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February, 1938.

4. Paragraph (a) of subclause (8) of clause 9 of the principal regulations (as substituted by the Training College Regulations 1926, Amendment No. 14,[†] hereinafter referred to as "Amendment No. 14") is amended by omitting the words "31st December preceding the date of the reopening of", and substituting the words "28th February of the year in which he is admitted".

5. Subclause (2) of clause 11 of the principal regulations (as substituted by Amendment No. 14) is amended by inserting, next after the words "per annum", the words "in the first and second year and an additional allowance at the rate of $\pounds 10$ per annum in the third year".

 \checkmark 6. Subclause (2) of clause 13 of the principal regulations (as substituted by Amendment No. 14) is amended by adding thereto the words "A student of Division C whose period of training has been extended for a further year shall receive an additional allowance at the rate of £10 per annum".
