THE RIGHT HON. M. J. SAVAGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Training College Regulations 1926, Amendment No. 17.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 13th day of December, 1926* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations"), as amended from time to time.
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1938.
- 4. Clause 11 of the principal regulations (as heretofore amended from time to time) is further amended by adding thereto the following subclause:—
- "(3A) A married male student may, with the approval of the Minister, be paid a further special allowance at a rate not exceeding the amount by which his other allowance or allowances taken together payable under subclauses (2) and (3) hereof are less than £209 15s."
- 5. Regulation 11 of the Education Amending Regulations 1937,† is amended by omitting the words "13th day of April, 1927," and substituting the words "13th day of December, 1926."
