

THE TRAINING COLLEGE REGULATIONS 1926, AMENDMENT NO. 19.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 30th day of November, 1938.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Training College Regulations 1926, Amendment No. 19.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 13th day of December, 1926* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.

4. Clause 4 of the principal regulations is further amended by adding thereto the following new subclause :---

"(3) (a) In addition to the model schools already included in a normal school a separate mixed school or any group of pupils therein, or a side school or any group of pupils therein attached to a mixed school or to a contributing school may be approved by the Minister as a school of Model I or Model II.

"(b) Any model school attached in accordance with the provisions of the last preceding paragraph shall be subject to the general supervision of the sole or head teacher thereof, but such model school shall be organized and managed as if it were a model school included in a normal school, and the Principal of the Training College shall have control of such organization and management.
