**THE TRAINING COLLEGE REGULATIONS 1926,  
AMENDMENT NO. 20.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of May, 1939.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Training College Regulations 1926, Amendment No. 20.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 13th day of December, 1926\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.†

4. Clause 3 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking subclause (3) thereof (as added by Order in Council on the 1st day of April, 1936), and substituting the following subclauses :—

“(3) For each training college there shall be, in addition to the Committee of Advice, a Board of Studies consisting of the Principal of the Training College, the Senior Inspector of Schools of the Education District in which the training college is situated, one representative of the Education Board controlling the Training College, and two representatives of the Professorial Board of the University College of the University District in which the training college is situated.

“(4) It shall be the duty of the Board of Studies to assist in co-ordinating the work of the training college with that of the University College, and, in particular, to determine the courses of study best suited to the individual needs and capacities of the students. The Board of Studies shall meet at least once in every term, and shall conduct its business in such manner as it thinks fit.

“(5) Any reports from the Board of Studies for the consideration of the Department shall be forwarded through the Education Board controlling the training college.”
