ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 41 of the Trustee Companies Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Trustee Companies (Fees) Regulations 1987.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1987.

2. Fee payable in respect of elections to administer—(1) The fee payable to a Registrar of the High Court for the filing of an election under Part III of the Trustee Companies Act 1967 shall be \$5.

(2) The sealing fee payable in respect of a copy of any such election shall be \$5.

3. Revocation—The Trustee Companies (Fees) Regulations 1981* are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations reduce from \$10 to \$5 the filing fee for an election to administer under Part III of the Trustee Companies Act 1967. The sealing fee for a copy of any such election remains at \$5.
