PURSUANT to section 7 of the Tariff Act 1988, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Tariff (Less Developed Countries and Least Developed Countries) Order 1989, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tariff (Less Developed Countries and Least Developed Countries) Order 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1991.

2. Less Developed Countries—The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by inserting, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the country "Bahrain".

3. Least Developed Countries—The Second Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by inserting, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the country "Namibia".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 1991, reflects the ratification of United Nations acceptance of Namibia as an LLDC, and reinstates Bahrain as an LDC as a result of its gross national product falling below seventy percent of New Zealand's gross national product.
