



THE TARIFF (LESS DEVELOPED COUNTRIES AND LEAST DEVELOPED COUNTRIES) ORDER 1993

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 8th day of June 1993

Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 7 of the Tariff Act 1988, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Tariff (Less Developed Countries and Least Developed Countries) Order 1993.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1993.

2. Less developed countries—Each of the countries named in the First Schedule to this order is hereby declared to be a less developed country for the purposes of the Tariff Act 1988.

3. Least developed countries—Each of the countries named in the Second Schedule to this order is hereby declared to be a least developed country for the purposes of the Tariff Act 1988.

4. Countries ceasing to be less developed countries—Each of the countries named in the Third Schedule to this order shall, on the coming

into force of this order, cease to be a less developed country for the purposes of the Tariff Act 1988.

5. Revocations—The orders specified in the Fourth Schedule to this order are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 August 1993, specifies the countries that qualify for Less Developed Countries Preference (LDC) and Least Developed Countries Preference (LLDC) in the Tariff.

This order differs from the existing order in that—

- (a) It declares the Czech Republic and the Slovak Republic (previously one republic known as the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic) to be less developed countries for the purposes of the Tariff Act 1988; and
- (b) It declares Cambodia (previously known as Kampuchea), Madagascar, the Federated States of Micronesia, Mozambique, Myanmar, Solomon Islands, Zaire, and Zambia to be least developed countries for the purposes of the Tariff Act 1988.
