# THE TROUT-FISHING (LAKES DISTRICT) REGULATIONS 1939.

# GALWAY, Governor-General.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 30th day of August, 1939.

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

# PRELIMINARY.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trout-fishing (Lakes District) Regulations 1939.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations for trout, perch, or tench fishing and netting in the Lakes District Acclimatization District (hereinafter referred to as the district) made on the 28th day of May, 1930\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. Terms used herein shall have the same meaning as in the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1936 (hereinafter referred to as the general regulations).
- 4. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1939.
- 5. Regulation No. 1 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—

## "OPEN SEASON.

- "1. Whole season licenses to fish for trout and other acclimatized fish issued by the Lakes District Acclimatization Society or any other acclimatization society under the general regulations shall entitle the holder to fish within the district as under:—
  - "(a) For trout and other acclimatized fish at any time between the 1st day of October in any one year and the 30th day of April in the year next following, both days inclusive, except in the waters of Lake Wanaka, or in any of the waters flowing into Lake Wanaka.

"(b) For trout and other acclimatized fish in Lake Wanaka, or in any of the waters flowing into Lake Wanaka, at any time between the 1st day of November in any one year and the 31st day of May in the year next following, both days inclusive."
