PURSUANT to section 46 (1) (v) of the Food and Drug Act 1969, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Therapeutic Drugs (Permitted Sales) Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Therapeutic Drugs (Permitted Sales) Regulations 1978\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Therapeutic drugs that may be sold freely**—Part II of the Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended from time to time) is hereby further amended by omitting the item "Ribena".
