THE TIMBER EXPORT DUTY ORDER, 1937.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Timber Export Act, 1908, and all other powers and authorities enabling in that behalf.

Date of enactment: 23rd day of June, 1937.

Date of notification in Gazette : 1st day of July, 1937.

1. This Order may be cited as the Timber Export Duty Order, 1937,

2. The Orders in Council set out in the First Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.

3. It is hereby directed that on and after the date of the coming into operation of this Order there shall be levied, collected, and paid at the Customs previous to exportation the duties upon timber set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

4. All duties which, by virtue of the Orders in Council hereby revoked, have become due and payable since the enactment thereof and before the coming into force of this Order, and all penalties and forfeitures which have been incurred, shall be recovered and enforced notwithstanding the revocation of the said Orders in Council by this Order.

5. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification of the making thereof in the Gazette.
