### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of July 1960

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Timber Export Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Timber Export Duty Revocation Order 1960.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Timber Export Duty Order 1937\* is hereby revoked.

3. All duties that have become due and payable and all penalties and forfeitures that have been incurred before the commencement of this order shall be recovered and enforced as if this order had not been made.
