THE TECHNOLOGY EXAMINATIONS REGULATIONS 1928, AMENDMENT NO. 4.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Education Act, 1914.

Date on which the regulations were made: 8th day of December, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 9th day of December, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations shall be cited as the Technology Examinations Regulations 1928, Amendment No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made on the 30th day of November, 1928* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 30th day of June, 1938.
- 4. The prescription in the principal regulations for the final examination course in Plumbing in Schedule I—Syllabuses of Examination—is amended by—
 - (1) Adding after "(a) Theory. Plans and Specifications" the following:—
 - "Trade Knowledge.—Knowledge of the principles applicable to the bending, jointing, welding, and brazing of metals."
 - (2) Deleting from "(b) Practice" the words "and copper pipes", and inserting the words "copper and other metal pipe jointing, welding, and brazing".
