**THE TEACHERS EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1941,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL.**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 23rd day of  
December, 1942.

Present :

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.**

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Teachers Emergency Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Teachers Emergency Regulations 1941\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Clause 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) By inserting, after the words “ Provided that ”, the words “ except with the prior approval of the Minister ”; and

(b) By adding the following subclause as subclause (2) :—

“ (2) Any approval given by the Minister for the purposes of the foregoing provisions of this clause may be given in respect of a specified applicant or in respect of applicants of a specified class, or may be given in respect of a specified war vacancy or in respect of war vacancies of a specified class.”

3. Clause 13 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) By inserting at the beginning of subclause (3) the words “ Except as provided in the next succeeding subclause ”; and

(b) By adding the following subclause :—

“(4) Notwithstanding anything in the last preceding subclause, a teacher holding a war appointment may, in special circumstances, resign at any time for the purpose of resuming his permanent position in accordance with the following provisions, namely :—

“(a) With the approval of the Public Service Commissioner, in the case of a teacher who is subject to the Public Service Act, 1912 :

“(b) With the approval of the Minister, in the case of a teacher who, by virtue of an Order in Council under section 17 of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1939, is under the control of the Minister :

“(c) With the approval of the Director, given on the recommendation of the Senior Inspector and of the Education Board by which the teacher is for the time being employed, in the case of a teacher holding a war appointment in a public school or a teachers' training college :

“(d) With the approval of the Director, given on the recommendation of the governing body or the controlling authority of any secondary school, technical school, or combined school, in the case if a teacher holding a war appointment in any such school, or, in the case of a teacher holding a war appointment at a manual-training centre, given on the recommendation of the authority controlling that centre.”
