



## THE TRANSPORT (TOWAGE FEES) NOTICE (NO. 2) 1990

PURSUANT to section 2 (1) of the Transport Act 1962, the Secretary for Transport hereby gives the following notice.

### NOTICE

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Towage Fees) Notice (No. 2) 1990.

(2) This notice shall apply with respect to parking offences committed on and after the 20th day of July 1990.

**2. Towage fees**—(1) The towage fee payable under the Transport Act 1962 in respect of any parking offence is—

(a) In the case of a vehicle whose gross weight does not exceed 3500 kg,—

(i) \$40, where the towage takes place between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday (other than a public holiday):

(ii) \$55, where the towage takes place at any other time:

(b) In the case of a vehicle whose gross weight exceeds 3500 kg,—

(i) \$100, where the towage takes place between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday (other than a public holiday):

(ii) \$150, where the towage takes place at any other time.

(2) The towage fees specified in this clause are inclusive of any amount of goods and services tax payable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

**3. Revocation**—The Transport (Towage Fees) Notice 1990 (S.R. 1990/140) is hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice, which prescribes the towage fees payable under the Transport Act 1962 in respect of parking offences, revokes and replaces the Transport (Towage Fees) Notice 1990 with effect from 20 July 1990. The new notice simply corrects a wrong cross-reference, and does not alter the towage fees set under the earlier notice.
