

# THE TAUPO FISHING REGULATIONS 1984, AMENDMENT NO. 2

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE RIGHT HON. G. W. R. PALMER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Maori Land Amendment and Maori Land Claims Adjustment Act 1926, and to the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1986.
- (3) Regulation 2 of these regulations shall apply to all licences issued in respect of any period commencing on or after that date.
- 2. Increase in licence fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 5 of the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 1), and

substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 5 of, and the Schedule to, the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase trout fishing licence fees by \$5 in the case of an adult wholeseason licence, by \$3 in the case of an adult monthly licence, by \$2.50 in the case of an adult weekly licence, and by \$1 in the case of an adult day licence.
