



**THE TAUPO FISHING REGULATIONS 1984,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 30th day of May 1988

THE RIGHT HON. DAVID LANGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Maori Land Amendment and Maori Land Claims Adjustment Act 1926, and to the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1988.

(3) These regulations shall apply in respect of all licences issued in respect of any period commencing on or after that date.

2. Licence fees—Regulation 8 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the words “(which fees are inclusive of goods and services tax payable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985)”.

3. Increase in licence fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The Taupo Fishing Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequentially revoked.
