ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 30th day of April 1990

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL  
PURSUANT to section 9 of the Tariff Act 1988, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the following order is necessary or advisable in the public interest and is in conformity with New Zealand's international obligations, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Tariff (Float Glass) Amendment Order 1990.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1990.

**2. Tariff amended**—The Tariff is hereby amended by revoking so much of Part I as relates to Tariff item 7005.29.00, and substituting the Tariff item, rates of duty, and statistical keys specified in the Schedule to this order.

**3. Consequential revocation**—The Tariff (Miscellaneous) Amendment Order (No. 4) 1989 (S.R. 1989/372) is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Schedule to that order as relates to Tariff item 7005.29.00.
