## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.
This order, which comes into force on 1 July 1994, provides for tariff rate changes under the product graduation policy relating to Less Developed Countries (LDCs). Under that policy, the value threshold used by the Government to determine whether any Tariff changes are necessary has been raised from $\$ 117,000$ to $\$ 120,000$ in accordance with the increase in the Producers Price Index for Manufacturing Outputs.
The order raises duty rates on certain Tariff items to the Normal duty rate as a result of various LDCs having reached the product graduation thresholds of a 25 percent share in, and $\$ 120,000$ value of, trade in the items involved.
It also reinstates preferential LDC rates on certain Tariff items by reason of trade in those items having fallen below those thresholds for 2 consecutive years.
