THE TOBACCO GROWING INDUSTRY REGULATIONS 1945,
AMENDMENT NO. 10

THE RIGHT HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Tobacco Growing Industry Act 1935, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 53, as substituted by regulation 2 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 8, and substituting the following regulation:

“53. Where the quantity of leaf for which compensation is to be allowed has been determined as aforesaid, the Board shall assess compensation according to the following rates:

Date of Loss	Compensation Per Pound of Leaf
Not later in the season than 15 January	d. 9½
Between 16 and 31 January (both days inclusive)	10
Between 1 February and 1 March (both days inclusive)	11
Between 2 and 31 March (both days inclusive)	12
Between 1 and 10 April (both days inclusive)	9½”

(2) The Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 8, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for increased rates of compensation in respect of loss suffered by tobacco growers up to 10 April in any season.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 27 June 1957.

These regulations are administered in the Department of Industries and Commerce.
