# ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 4th day of June 1974

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 26 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Act 1935, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—These regulations may be cited as the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 20, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Contract quantity of air dried leaf—(1) Regulation 49 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations, Amendment No. 6, and amended by regulation 2 of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations Amendment No. 16) is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words "but not exceeding in any case a weight exceeding 1,250 lb an acre".
- (2) The Tobacco Growing Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 16, are hereby consequentially amended by revoking regulation 2.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the definition of the expression "contract quantity", in relation to air dried leaf, by eliminating the limit of 1,250 lb an acre.
