Pursuant to the Tobacco Growing Industry Act, 1935, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tobacco Growing Industry Regulations 1945\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations).
- 2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by omitting from regulation 9 the words "1s. for every thousand pounds", and substituting the words "2s. for every thousand pounds".

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations increase the fee payable for a warrant to purchase raw tobacco from 1s. a thousand pounds or part thereof to 2s. a thousand pounds or part thereof.
