**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of October 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 13 (2) of the Tourist Hotel Corporation Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Finance made on the recommendation of the Tourist Hotel Corporation of New Zealand, pursuant to a resolution in that behalf passed by the Corporation, and with the concurrence of the Minister of Tourism, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Tourist Hotel Corporation (Increase in Capital) Order 1976.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Capital of Tourist Hotel Corporation**—The capital of the Tourist Hotel Corporation of New Zealand (as prescribed in section 13 (1) of the Tourist Hotel Corporation Act 1974) is hereby increased from \$4,000,000 to \$6,281,350.
