



**THE TOURIST HOTEL CORPORATION (INCREASE IN
CAPITAL) ORDER (NO. 2) 1978**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 4th day of December 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 13 (2) of the Tourist Hotel Corporation Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister of Finance (which advice follows the making to that Minister, pursuant to a resolution of the Tourist Hotel Corporation of New Zealand and with the concurrence of the Minister of Tourism, of a recommendation that the capital of the Corporation be increased), hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Tourist Hotel Corporation (Increase in Capital) Order (No. 2) 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Capital of Tourist Hotel Corporation—The capital of the Tourist Hotel Corporation of New Zealand (as prescribed by section 13 (1) of the Tourist Hotel Corporation Act 1974 and increased by clause 2 of the Tourist Hotel Corporation (Increase in Capital) Order 1978) is hereby increased from \$6,448,000 to \$11,448,000.

3. Revocation—The Tourist Hotel Corporation (Increase in Capital) Order 1978* is hereby consequentially revoked.
