**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act, 1949 (hereinafter called the said Act), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Transport (Auckland Harbour-ferry Services) Order 1949.
2. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1949.
3. It is hereby declared that the Auckland Harbour shall be a harbour-ferry service district for the purposes of Part VI of the said Act with the name of the Auckland Harbour-ferry Service District and that the provisions of the said Part VI shall apply to the harbour-ferry services specified in the Schedule hereto.

**SCHEDULE**

**HARBOUR-FERRY SERVICES TO WHICH PROVISIONS APPLY**

1. All harbour-ferry services between Auckland and the boroughs of Birkenhead, Devonport, Northcote, and Takapuna, or between any one of the said boroughs and any other or others of the said boroughs.
2. All harbour-ferry services between Auckland and the Waiheke Island and Pine Island.
