PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Transport (Auckland Harbour-Ferry Services) Order 1949, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Transport (Auckland Harbour-Ferry Services) Order 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Clause 3 of the principal order is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

“Provided that nothing in this order shall apply to any harbour ferry carrying passengers for the Auckland Harbour Board, the Customs Department, the Police, or any shipping company under a contract expressed or implied for the use of the vessel as a whole.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to exempt from licensing vessels which are hired under contract to the Auckland Harbour Board, the Customs Department, the Police, or any shipping company.
