THE HON. D. MACINTYRE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Technical Institute and Community College Boards Employment Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Technical Institute and Community College Boards Employment Regulations 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Morning and afternoon tea—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 33, the following regulation:

"33A. (1) Subject to subclause (2) of this regulation, each Board shall provide sufficient tea, coffee, sugar, and milk to make a drink available for each employee during each morning and afternoon break provided for in regulation 30 (2) of these regulations.

"(2) Where no such drink can be made available to an employee in accordance with subclause (1) of this regulation the Board shall pay him an allowance at the same rate as that for the time being determined by the State Services Commission in respect of persons employed in the Public Service."
