**THE TOKELAU ISLANDS MARRIAGE REGULATIONS 1969,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of July 1975

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Tokelau Islands Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Tokelau Islands Marriage Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tokelau Islands Marriage Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1975.

2. Marriage of persons within prohibited degrees of relationship void—(1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to clause 1 the following paragraphs:

“(21) Father’s brother’s daughter:

“(22) Father’s sister’s daughter:

“(23) Mother’s brother’s daughter:

“(24) Mother’s sister’s daughter.”

(2) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by adding to clause 2 the following paragraphs:

“(21) Father’s brother’s son:

“(22) Father’s sister’s son:

“(23) Mother’s brother’s son:

“(24) Mother’s sister’s son:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of these regulations is to prohibit, in the Tokelau Islands, marriage between first cousins.
