If the fee is not paid before the date specified in this notice, proceedings for failure to pay may be taken under the Summary Proceedings Act 1957 for an offence under section 194A (8) of the Transport Act 1962, which reads:

“Every person commits an offence and is liable to a fine not exceeding five dollars who, being the driver or person in charge of the vehicle concerned at the time of the commission of a parking infringement, and having been served with a parking-infringement notice relating to that infringement, fails without reasonable cause,

proof of which cause shall lie on the defendant, to pay to the local authority before the date specified in the notice the fee specified in the notice.”

If proceedings are taken, and without restricting any other defence you may consider you have, you are entitled to defend the charge on the grounds that no parking infringement was committed or that you were not the driver or person in charge of the vehicle.

*If you were not the driver (or person in charge) of the motor vehicle specified above at the time and place shown, you may either ensure that the specified fee is paid or you must write in the space below the full name, address, and occupation of the driver of the vehicle—*

PLEASE NOTE that, unless the fee payable to the local authority in respect of the infringement is paid before the date specified in this notice, the owner of a motor vehicle shall give to the traffic officer all information in his possession or obtainable by him which may lead to the identification of the driver or person in charge of the vehicle at the time of the alleged infringement as required by section 67 of the Transport Act 1962.

30 minutes or less .....	1.00
Over 30 minutes but not over 1 hour .....	1.50
Over 1 hour but not over 1½ hours .....	2.50
Over 1½ hours but not over 2 hours .....	3.50
Over 2 hours .....	5.00
