THE TRANSPORT (PARKING INFRINGEMENTS) NOTICE 1970

PURSUANT to section 194A of the Transport Act 1962 (as inserted by section 27 (1) of the Transport Amendment Act 1968 and amended by section 21 of the Transport Amendment Act 1969), the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Parking Infringements) Notice 1970.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Form of notice to driver—Every notice specified in subsection (11) of the said section 194A of the Transport Act 1962 shall be in the form set out in the First Schedule to this notice.

3. Form of parking-infringement notice—Every parking-infringement notice under the said section 194A of the Transport Act 1962 shall be in the form set out in the Second Schedule to this notice.

4. Parking-infringement fees—The fees specified in the Third Schedule to this notice are hereby prescribed as the maximum parking-infringement fees payable under the said section 194A of the Transport Act 1962.

5. Revocation—The Transport (Parking Infringements) Notice 1969* is hereby revoked.

If the fee is not paid before the date specified in this notice, proceedings for failure to pay may be taken under the Summary Proceedings Act 1957 for an offence under section 194A (8) of the Transport Act 1962, which reads:

SECOND SCHEDULE—continued

"Every person commits an offence and is liable to a fine not exceeding five dollars who, being the driver or person in charge of the vehicle concerned at the time of the commission of a parking infringement, and having been served with a parking-infringement notice relating to that infringement, fails to pay to the local authority before the date specified in the notice the fee specified in the notice."

If proceedings are taken, and without restricting any other defence you may consider you have, you are entitled to defend the charge on the grounds that no parking infringement was committed or that you were not the driver or person in charge of the vehicle.

If you were not the driver (or person in charge) of the motor vehicle specified above at the time and place shown, you may either ensure that the specified fee is paid or you must write in the space below the full name, address, and occupation of the driver of the vehicle—

and forward this notice to the traffic officer whose signature and address appear below.

PLEASE NOTE that, unless the fee payable to the local authority in respect of the infringement is paid before the date specified in this notice, the owner of a motor vehicle shall give to the traffic officer all information in his possession or obtainable by him which may lead to the identification of the driver or person in charge of the vehicle at the time of the alleged infringement as required by section 67 of the Transport Act 1962.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This notice replaces the Transport (Parking Infringements) Notice 1969, which prescribes the forms of notice to driver and parking-infringement notice for the purposes of section 194A of the Transport Act 1962 and the scale of maximum parking-infringement fees payable under that section.

parking-infringement fees payable under that section. The only change is in the form of parking-infringement notice, which now sets out a copy of section 194A (8) of the Transport Act 1962 as amended by section 21 of the Transport Amendment Act 1969.
