THE TRANSPORT (PARKING INFRINGEMENTS) NOTICE 1974

PURSUANT to section 194A of the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Parking Infringements) Notice 1974.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Form of notice to driver—Every notice specified in subsection (11) of the said section 194A of the Transport Act 1962 shall be in the form set out in the First Schedule to this notice.

3. Form of parking-infringement notice—Every parking-infringement notice under the said section 194A of the Transport Act 1962 shall be in the form set out in the Second Schedule to this notice.

4. Parking-infringement fees—The fees specified in the Third Schedule to this notice are hereby prescribed as the maximum parking-infringement fees payable under the said section 194A of the Transport Act 1962.

5. Revocation—The Transport (Parking Infringements) Notice 1970* is hereby revoked.

Over 30 minutes but not over 1 hour	2.00
Over 1 hour but not over 2 hours	4.00
Over 2 hours but not over 4 hours	8.00
Over 4 hours	10.00
