THE TRANSPORT (PARKING INFRINGEMENTS) NOTICE 1975

Pursuant to section 194A of the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Transport (Parking Infringements) Notice 1975.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the date of its notification

in the Gazette.

- 2. Form of notice to driver—Every notice specified in subsection (11) of the said section 194A of the Transport Act 1962 shall be in the form set out in the First Schedule to this notice.
- 3. Form of parking-infringement notice—Every parking-infringement notice under the said section 194A of the Transport Act 1962 shall be in the form set out in the Second Schedule to this notice.
- 4. Parking-infringement fees—The fees specified in the Third Schedule to this notice are hereby prescribed as the maximum parking-infringement fees payable under the said section 194A of the Transport Act 1962.
- 5. Revocation—The Transport (Parking Infringements) Notice 1974* is hereby revoked.

If the fee is not paid before the date specified in this notice, proceedings for failure to pay may be taken under the Summary Proceedings Act 1957 for an offence under section 194A (8) of the Transport Act 1962, which reads:
"Every person commits an offence and is liable to a fine not exceeding \$5, who, being the driver or person in charge of the vehicle concerned at the time of the commission of a parking infringement, and having been served with a parking-infringement notice relating to that infringement, fails to pay to the local authority, or, where the notice was issued by an officer of the Ministry of Transport, to an office of the Ministry, before the date specified in the notice the fee specified in the notice." If proceedings are taken, and without restricting any other defence
you may consider you have, you are entitled to defend the charge on the grounds that no parking infringement was committed or that you
were not the driver or person in charge of the vehicle.
If you were not the driver (or person in charge) of the motor vehicle specified above at the time and place shown, you may either ensure that the specified fee is paid or you must write in the space below the full name, address, and occupation of the driver of the vehicle— Name of Driver (or person in charge):

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The only changes are the insertion in the form of notice of references to payment to an office of the Ministry of Transport, and are consequential on the amendment to section 194A (8) of the Transport Act 1962 made by section 6 of the Transport Amendment Act (No. 2) 1975.
