**THE TOBACCO-GROWING INDUSTRY REGULATIONS 1945,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Tobacco-growing Industry Act, 1935, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Tobacco-growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tobacco-growing Industry Regulations 1945\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1946.

4. The principal regulations are hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) By omitting from Regulation 33 the words "on or after the 1st day of January in any season", and substituting the words "in any season between the 24th day of December in any year and the 10th day of April in the next succeeding year (both days inclusive)".
- (b) By omitting from Regulation 38 the words "1st day of January", and substituting the words "24th day of December".
- (c) By omitting from the table to Regulation 49 the figure "10,000", and substituting the figure "9,000".

- (d) By inserting, after the word "contract" where it first appears in Regulation 52, the words "or if in the opinion of the Board the quantity stated in a notified contract exceeds the quantity the grower could have reasonably expected to produce from the area planted out".
- (c) By inserting in Regulation 53, after the words "On or after 16th February", the words "but not later than 10th April".
