THE TOBACCO-GROWING INDUSTRY REGULATIONS 1945, AMENDMENT NO. 14

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 4th day of March 1963

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Tobacco Growing Industry Act 1935, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Tobacco-Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 14, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Tobacco-Growing Industry Regulations 1945* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 50 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Tobacco-Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 6, and as amended by regulation 2 of the Tobacco-Growing Industry Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 12) is hereby further amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

“(1) The number of pounds of flue-cured leaf which a grower could reasonably expect to cure efficiently in a season shall be determined by the number and the size of the kilns available to him, and the capacity of a kiln shall be deemed, for the purposes of these regulations, not to exceed the weight of leaf indicated in respect of the kiln in the following tables:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations substitute new tables for the existing tables indicating the capacity of kilns for the purpose of determining the number of pounds of flue-cured leaf which a grower could expect to cure efficiently in a season.
