HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act, 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

O R D E R

1. This Order may be cited as the Transport Licensing Exemption Order 1950.

2. The class of goods-services specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby exempted from licensing under Part VI of the Transport Act, 1949.

SCHEDULE

CLASS OF EXEMPTED GOODS-SERVICES

GOODS-SERVICES carried on exclusively for the purpose of the painting, repair, or maintenance of petrol pumps and the underground equipment appurtenant to them.
